Judging Process: A panel of judges or the community will score the builds based on the categories above. Each judge will rate each category on a scale of 1-10.

Q&A:

Q: Can I build any outside builds around the snowman?

A: Yes, feel free to have a winter-themed setting. Feel free to add any accessories, characters, etc.

Q: Can I play on console?

A: No. This is a only Java server.

Q: Can we build any kind of snowman, or does it have to be traditional (3 snowballs, a carrot nose, etc.)?

A: You're free to get creative! While the classic snowman style is encouraged, we'd love to see unique interpretations. Think outside the box—add accessories, funny poses, or even a snowman with a backstory. The sky's the limit!

Q: What materials are allowed for the snowman?

A: Any!

Q: Can I team up with others for this event?

A: No! This is only a solo build event.

Q: Can I use mods, texture packs, or other tools for my build?

A: No mods, texture packs, or external tools are allowed. This is a vanilla Minecraft event, so all builds should be created with the game's default mechanics.

Q: Can I interact with other players during the event?

A: As long as you're not griefing or destroying others' builds, feel free to interact. If the event is streamed or being watched, it might be fun to chat with others, but make sure you're respecting everyone's build time.
